

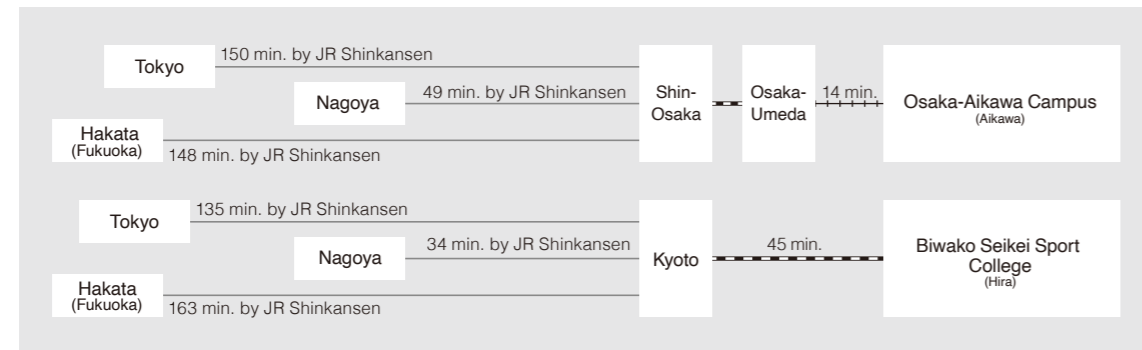
Access

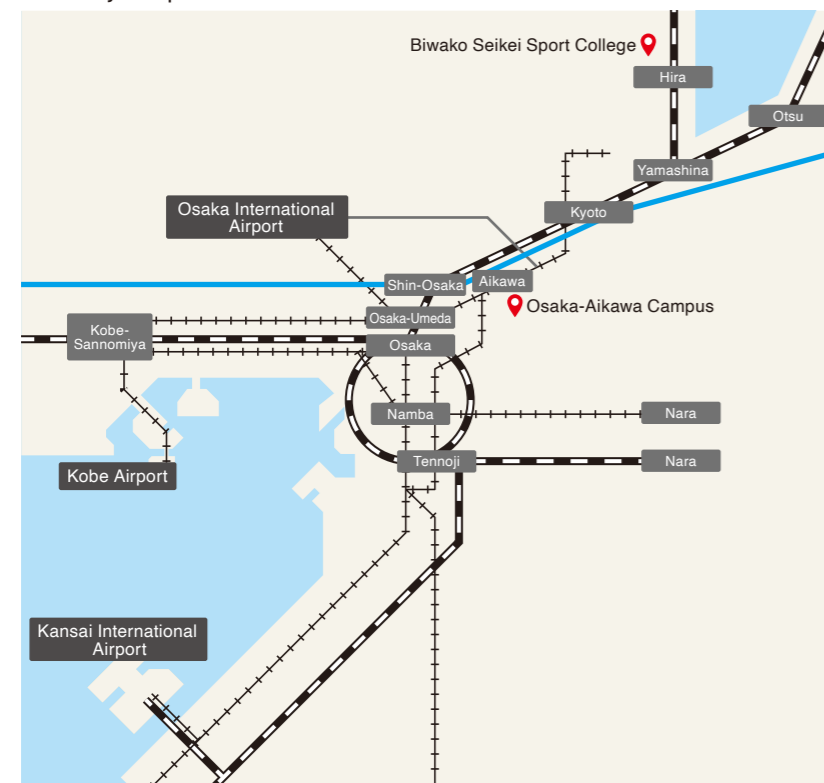
It's just 14 minutes by train from Osaka-Umeda Station in central Osaka.

Message from the Chairperson

Founded in 1933, Osaka Seikei Gakuen has over 90 years of history. Our group of schools comprises Osaka Seikei University, Biwako Seikei Sport College, Osaka Seikei College, Osaka Seikei Girls' High School, and Komichi Kindergarten. We have around 7,800 students enrolled and 137,000 alumni.

Osaka Seikei Gakuen's educational philosophy derives from a Chinese proverb recorded by Sima Qian in the ancient *Records of the Grand Historian*. The proverb states, "Peaches and plums don't speak, but people gather beneath them, drawn by their flowers and fruits. In time, a path to the trees emerges." Interpreting this allegory, we say that someone with integrity will draw others who admire their virtue.

At Osaka Seikei Gakuen, we act on the principles of *chujō* ("faithfulness and kindness"). In our actions, we follow our conscience and consider others.

To embody the educational philosophy of Osaka Seikei Gakuen, you need what we call "human qualities." These are the qualities we foster in our students:

1. Being full of vitality, having a strong body and a flexible mind;
2. Displaying a level of reading, writing, listening, and speaking able to meet global standards;
3. Being able to interact well with others, but still act and think independently;
4. Having sound judgement and a broad perspective for problem solving;
5. Being curious, ambitious, and persistent in the face of obstacles;
6. Understanding others, valuing personal bonds, being loyal and kind.

In recent years, we have conducted wide-ranging educational reforms aimed at fostering lifelong learning and global competence and assuring the quality of our

education for the 21st century and beyond. Faculty and staff are working on numerous projects with these goals in mind.

I hope Osaka Seikei Gakuen will attract even more students in the future, and that they'll become well-respected individuals who use the knowledge and expertise they gain here to serve their communities and organizations.

<p>Osaka Seikei University</p>		<p>Founded in 2003, the university comprises six faculties: Management, Global Tourism & Management, Education, Arts, Data Science, and Nursing Science. Our education emphasizes project-based learning.</p>
<p>Biwako Seikei Sport College</p>		<p>This college was founded in 2003. Our eight programs provide multifaceted learning of sports, such as School Sports and Sport Business. Our campus is set in the natural surroundings of Lake Biwa and the Hira Mountains.</p>
<p>Osaka Seikei College</p>		<p>Since our founding in 1951, we have grown to be one of Japan's largest comprehensive junior colleges. Our four faculties include Preschool Education and Cookery and Confectionery. So far, we have turned out approximately 70,000 graduates.</p>
<p>Osaka Seikei Girls' High School</p>		<p>Originating from a girls' school founded in 1933, we offer eight courses in two departments. Our focus is on career education and global education.</p>
<p>Komichi Kindergarten</p>		<p>Founded in 1952. Education here incorporates the results of preschool education research conducted at Osaka Seikei University and Osaka Seikei College.</p>

The Kinki region, comprising the seven prefectures of Osaka, Kyoto, Mie, Shiga, Nara, Wakayama, and Hyogo, is located slightly west of Japan's geographical center. For many years, it flourished as the heart of Japan's government, culture, and trade and boasts a long history and rich traditional culture. Besides the ancient capitals of Kyoto and Nara, other attractive cities include Osaka—one of Japan's largest metropolitan areas after Tokyo—and Kobe, a vibrant and scenic port. Flanked by the Sea of Japan and the Pacific Ocean, and boasting natural wonders like Lake Biwa—Japan's largest lake—and numerous mountains, the Kinki region attracts people from around the world.

Convenient, Vibrant Location

Osaka Seikei University, Osaka Seikei College, Osaka Seikei Girls' High School, and Komichi Kindergarten are located in Higashiyodogawa-ku, in the northeast of Osaka City between two large rivers, the Yodogawa and the Kanzakigawa. It is easy to get to and from, with a network of nearby train lines offering convenient access to major stations like Osaka Station and Kyoto Station. There are numerous other universities not far away, so the area and its environs are home to a vibrant youth culture that includes many overseas students. Furthermore, Osaka Seikei Gakuen enjoys close ties to local governments in Osaka, Kyoto, and other cities, and companies in the region, so students often visit these partners as part of their locally themed class assignments. Osaka Seikei Gakuen also strives to be a good citizen by holding community exchange events and lectures open to the public.

Learn in a Spacious, Natural Setting

Biwako Seikei Sport College is located in Hira, Otsu City, Shiga Prefecture, about 40 minutes by train from Kyoto. Surrounded by expansive natural beauty, its large campus provides ample opportunity to learn and practice sports. And its proximity to the Hira Mountains and Lake Biwa provides unparalleled access to camping and water sports. Students of Biwako Seikei Sport College also work closely together in study and research with their counterparts at the Aikawa campus, home to Osaka Seikei University, Osaka Seikei College, and Osaka Seikei Girls' High School.

Faculty of Management

- Department of Management
- Department of Sports Management

Students learn about the resources of business management—people, goods, money, information—and how these interconnect. The most important thing in business is to collaborate with others to create new value. Students grow into individuals capable of creating such new value by studying how management can successfully solve the problems of companies and organizations. Two new programs start in academic year 2026. (See page 12.)



Features of the Faculty

- Through joint product development with the likes of major convenience stores, food companies, professional sports teams, and local governments, students develop their thinking and practical skills.
- Internships provide work experience and are aimed at second- and third-year students. Approximately 120 students participated in internships in academic year 2024. We also conduct overseas internships in collaboration with international companies.
- All students participate in PBL (project-based learning) classes, in which they polish their active learning skills by collecting information and creating solutions and plans in response to tasks presented to them by companies and local governments.



Department of Management

International Business Program (2026)

Students have many opportunities for active learning in the classroom and will naturally acquire planning and problem-solving skills. The program also offers the chance for learning about international relations, international politics, and the history and culture of various regions around the world. In this atmosphere, students will deepen their international and intercultural understanding and acquire the skills necessary to be a global citizen.



Accounting Program (2026)

Accounting is the common language of business. Students learn bookkeeping procedures and acquire the skills to do everything from recording a daily company ledger to creating financial statements. They also develop the ability to grasp a company's business situation, including its profitability, solvency, and efficiency.



Management Program

Students learn modules including product development, marketing, and management strategy that can then be applied to a wide range of industries. They also examine social needs and develop problem-solving skills to boost corporate growth.



Public Management Program

A program for national and local civil servants, police officers, and firefighters. It teaches all the requisite knowledge of how national and local governments operate and nurtures candidates capable of planning and implementing solutions to counter various problems such as the declining/aging population in Japan, income inequality, disasters, and environmental issues.



Food Business Program

Students learn three core areas of the food industry: management, informatics, and food science. They team up with companies and local governments to tackle product development, sales promotion, and store management techniques, honing their ability to spark joy and enrich lives through food and cuisine.



Department of Sports Management

Amidst the recent holding of major sporting events and a growing awareness of health and fitness, the sports industry looks set to catalyze the Japanese economy going forward. In this department, we teach marketing and promotion strategies tailored for the sports industry and nurture candidates well-placed to contribute to the same.



Faculty of Global Tourism & Management

Department of Global Tourism & Management

Following the Japanese government's guidelines, our programs teach tourism in a multifaceted and effective way that is suited to the post-pandemic world. In revising the Tourism Nation Promotion Basic Plan, the government has three strategies: 1) Creating sustainable tourism destinations where there is a balance between tourism and the preservation of nature and culture; 2) Helping inbound tourism recover by increasing consumption and attracting visitors to rural areas; and 3) Expanding domestic tourism through, for example, the Second Hometown project.



Features of the Faculty

- Through the perspective of business administration, students learn about the new types of tourism sought by society. In earning their four-year Bachelor of Business Administration degree, students learn business management as it relates to tourism, and acquire knowledge and skill that will serve them well in all aspects of their profession, home life, and society.
- In the STEP Study Abroad program, students study outside Japan twice during their four years: once in their first year and once in their third. They can choose their destination and length of stay, and receive comprehensive study-abroad financial support such as scholarships.
- Students can gain first-hand experience in working environments through programs and internships in which the university collaborates with regional governments and the private sector. Through PBL (project-based learning), students take on challenges of real-world problems in workplaces including travel agencies, hotels, airlines, airports, and local governments.



Department of Global Tourism & Management

Tourism Business Program

Tourism is a broad-based industry that includes travel agencies, hotels, airlines, and railway companies. In this program, students will aim for a career in the tourism industry by studying subjects like corporate business strategies, marketing, and management. Faculty members, including experienced professionals, educate students to become tourism professionals capable of working anywhere in Japan or around the world.



Tourism Hospitality Program

A key determiner of a traveler's satisfaction is the interaction with staff at hotels, shops, and on modes of transportation. In this program, students will learn the theory and practice of interpersonal service and communication grounded in a hospitality mindset. Graduates will be active on the front lines of tourism and hospitality in settings such as hotels, airlines and airports, hotels and wedding service providers, and theme parks.



Tourism Culture Development Program

The most important motivator for going on a trip is what awaits the traveler at their destination. Besides conventional reasons for a trip, like enjoying nature and history, today's tourists are attracted by activities and experiences such as anime and film locations, sweets and cuisine, art and museums, and World Heritage sites. In this program, students will learn about tourism and regional revitalization policies, including the creation of attractive tourism experiences and the planning of travel itineraries.



Faculty of Education

- Division of Secondary School Education
- Division of Primary School Education

The Faculty of Education stresses thorough, real-life practice. We develop teachers who can educate and care for students and children through a tireless passion for education, a close attachment to those they teach, and the ability to put training to practical use. The curriculum gives them practical lessons and valuable in-school practicums, and it reflects the needs of today's schools. We also give students practice towards passing the teachers' certification exam before they graduate, and we offer support in finding a teaching job after graduation.



Features of the Faculty

- A high percentage of students pass the teachers' certification exam, and in the eight years since the faculty was established all of our graduates have found employment (graduates from 2018 to 2025).
- Students can choose from five kinds of teaching licenses depending on their desire to work at a kindergarten, elementary school, junior/senior high school, or special-needs school.
- Students do their second-year experience and third- and fourth-year practicum (three years total) at the same kindergarten or school, giving them more thorough on-site training.
- Students get a wealth of experience in on-site training, as well as guidance from instructors with experience on education committees and in academic societies.



Division of Secondary School Education

English Education Program

English language education has never been more important than now, in today's increasingly globalized world. This program is intended for future English teachers and designed to enhance their ability to teach in English. Students benefit from time spent in overseas educational institutions, including the U.S. and Australia, to refine their international perspective as educators.



Health and Physical Education Program

This program helps students gain the skills required for practical instruction with athletics and ball games and understand sports medical science, preventive medicine, competitive characteristics, and physical well-being. It trains teachers with the right scientific grounding for PE classes and club guidance.



Division of Primary School Education

Elementary Education Program

Based on the content of elementary school education, students learn educational theory and gain the teaching and class management skills required through numerous trial lessons and on-site training to create lessons that are as appealing as possible to children.



Preschool Education Program

Students gain insights into infant development and psychology and develop a range of childcare techniques, including music, art, and exercise. They are trained as kindergarten or nursery school teachers to support the mental and physical development of children.



Graduate School

Master's Program in Education, Graduate School of Education

Students collaborate with local schools, nurseries, and other entities involved in educating children while reflecting on a range of educational practices. We train advanced education professionals who can solve problems creatively. We have established a system for teachers already employed to learn while continuing their careers.

Faculty of Arts

■ Department of Art & Design

Students can achieve their dreams in any of eight programs in the Faculty of Arts. They will pursue art in a field of interest and then use what they learn upon graduation. Besides acquiring highly specialized skills, students grow into well-rounded individuals. We encourage students to think of the role art and design can play in society and mold them into people who can turn possibilities into realities.



Features of the Faculty

- Students get education in state-of-the-art design.
- In industry-government-academia project exercises, students work in teams at companies and local governments to practice using art to solve social issues.
- We hold public exhibitions where students show their work, including a third-year exhibition, a graduate exhibition, and a fashion show.
- Internships at design firms and ad agencies give students a chance early on to experience the creativity industry.
- Career counseling and job placement support help students get on their desired path.

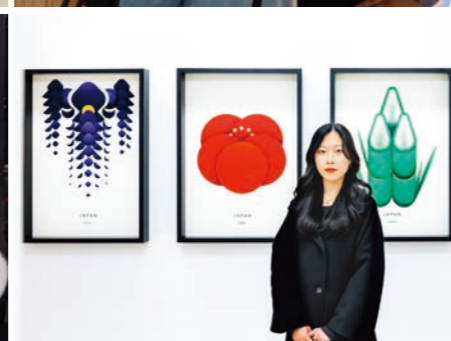

Department of Data Science

We foster specialists who can transform data into value

Data science is a field of study that takes the vast range of data available in society and analyzes it using algorithms, statistics, and AI to find useful knowledge and create new value for society and organizations. Data science is being introduced into all sorts of fields, including economics, government, transportation, medicine, education, the environment, sports, and entertainment. Our faculty trains specialists who can turn data into value for society.



Features of the Faculty

- Field-specific specialized data science education**

Three new programs have been created: Business Data Science, Advanced Information Strategy, and Sports & Health Data Science.

- The Future Creation Project, starting in the first year**

Students study first-hand advanced cases of data science utilization to understand its depth and appeal. Diverse learning is led by faculty specializing in a range of expertise.

- Cutting-edge data science education environment**

As a base for seminar activities, the Faculty of Data Science has established a joint research area called Co-Labo, one of the few private university facilities in Japan where faculty and students work and study side by side.



Department of Data Science

Business Data Science Program

In a society where information technology is becoming increasingly advanced and difficult to predict, we develop students who combine the ability to analyze, understand, and utilize AI and data with the 'human qualities' that people can trust, and who can create, maintain, and develop new businesses.

Advanced Information Strategy Program

Students will acquire practical analytical skills based on constantly evolving, cutting-edge information technology, and the ability to clearly communicate the results of analysis. The goal is to cultivate students who can support strategic decision-making in a variety of corporate activities.

Sports & Health Data Science Program

Students will learn techniques to optimize training, analyze team strength, and estimate mental and physical states using eye trackers, motion sensors, and other cutting-edge sensing and visualization technologies. The program aims to develop talent who can use data and AI to bring about innovation in the fields of sports and health.

Training nurses who put compassion into care

In today's rapidly aging society, registered nurses are needed in increasing numbers of situations including in medical institutions, nursing facilities, and homes. Beyond just hospitals, society needs registered nurses who have a deep understanding of multi-professional collaboration with doctors and public health nurses and who can meet the diverse and complex medical and care needs of their community. The Faculty of Nursing Science trains registered nurses and public health nurses to have the necessary professional knowledge, the problem-solving skills to meet diverse medical needs, and the keen interpersonal skills that earn the trust of patients and their families.



Features of the Faculty

- **Three programs to realize students' ideal future**

We have three programs. The first is for those who want to master nursing as a registered nurse. The second is for those who want to become both a registered nurse and a public health nurse. The third is for those who want to work as a school nurse.

- **Deepen students' understanding of community-based care systems and multi-professional collaboration**

We have a wide range of educational programs that develop the ability to collaborate with and support other medical professionals and local residents as a part of a community-based care system.

- **Abundant training sites, mainly in the Osaka-Kyoto-Kobe area**

By combining classes on campus with training at various major medical institutions in the Osaka-Kyoto-Kobe area, students will develop advanced practical skills.



Department of Nursing Science

Three programs reflecting Japan's medical and nursing needs

The number of people who need nursing care continues to increase every year, and nurses who can respond to the increasingly diverse and complex medical and nursing needs are in high demand. In this faculty, students systematically learn the requisite knowledge and its practical application. The goal is to be able to respond to the increasingly sophisticated and diverse medical and nursing needs of the community. Depending on their own professional vision, students can choose from three programs: registered nursing, public health nursing, and school nursing.

Faculty of Preschool Education

We train students to become nursery or kindergarten teachers who can support the individual development of each child. Through practical training, students build their understanding of children's physical and mental growth. They study the theory of education, childcare, and welfare. They also acquire the skills needed for giving classes in art, physical education, and music—with a special focus on the piano.



Features of the Faculty

- Under the guidance of instructors with real teaching experience, students take a balanced curriculum of lectures and practica.
- The college has close relationships with partner institutes where students get strong support in their practica.
- There are 115 pianos for use, and students get tailored individual instruction whether they are beginners or advanced.



Faculty of Nutrition

As the developed world deals with aging populations and increases in lifestyle diseases, there is growing interest in diet and health. Dieticians and school nutritionists have an important role to play. Students prepare large-scale meal plans and perform dietetics experiments to gain the necessary professional skills and knowledge.



Features of the Faculty

- Students hone their skills under the guidance of working dieticians at institutes such as elementary schools and welfare facilities.
- More than 80% of graduates go on to work as dieticians.
- Students obtain a dietician's license upon graduation, and they can also aim for a registered dietician's license.



Faculty of Cookery and Confectionery

Students undergo specialized learning in two food-related programs. Under the guidance of instructors widely experienced in the field and utilizing the college's wealth of equipment, they improve their skills in order to gain employment in a range of sectors and jobs. They can also obtain a national license; for example, as a cook or as a licensed confectionery specialist. There are also numerous opportunities, such as contests and graduate cooking/baking exhibits, for students to display the prowess gained in their study.



Culinary Arts Program

Students learn to prepare various cuisines, including Japanese, Western, and Chinese. Upon graduation, they acquire a national license as a cook. Students are also taught professional etiquette and other relevant knowledge.



Pastry Arts Program

Confectionery should both look and taste good; but it should also be safe to eat. Students in this program acquire confectionery-making skills and knowledge of food hygiene. They can also aim to become a licensed confectionery specialist.



Advanced Culinary Department (2026)

This new department, opening in 2026, will nurture the talent and intellectual curiosity of students to help them master the craft.



Faculty of Apparel Design

There are two programs in apparel and fashion. Full-fledged fashion shows are held so students can experience the entire range of work in the apparel and fashion industry. With the college being one of the few in Japan offering training for a second-grade textiles advisor license, students can aim for a variety of qualifications in apparel and fashion.

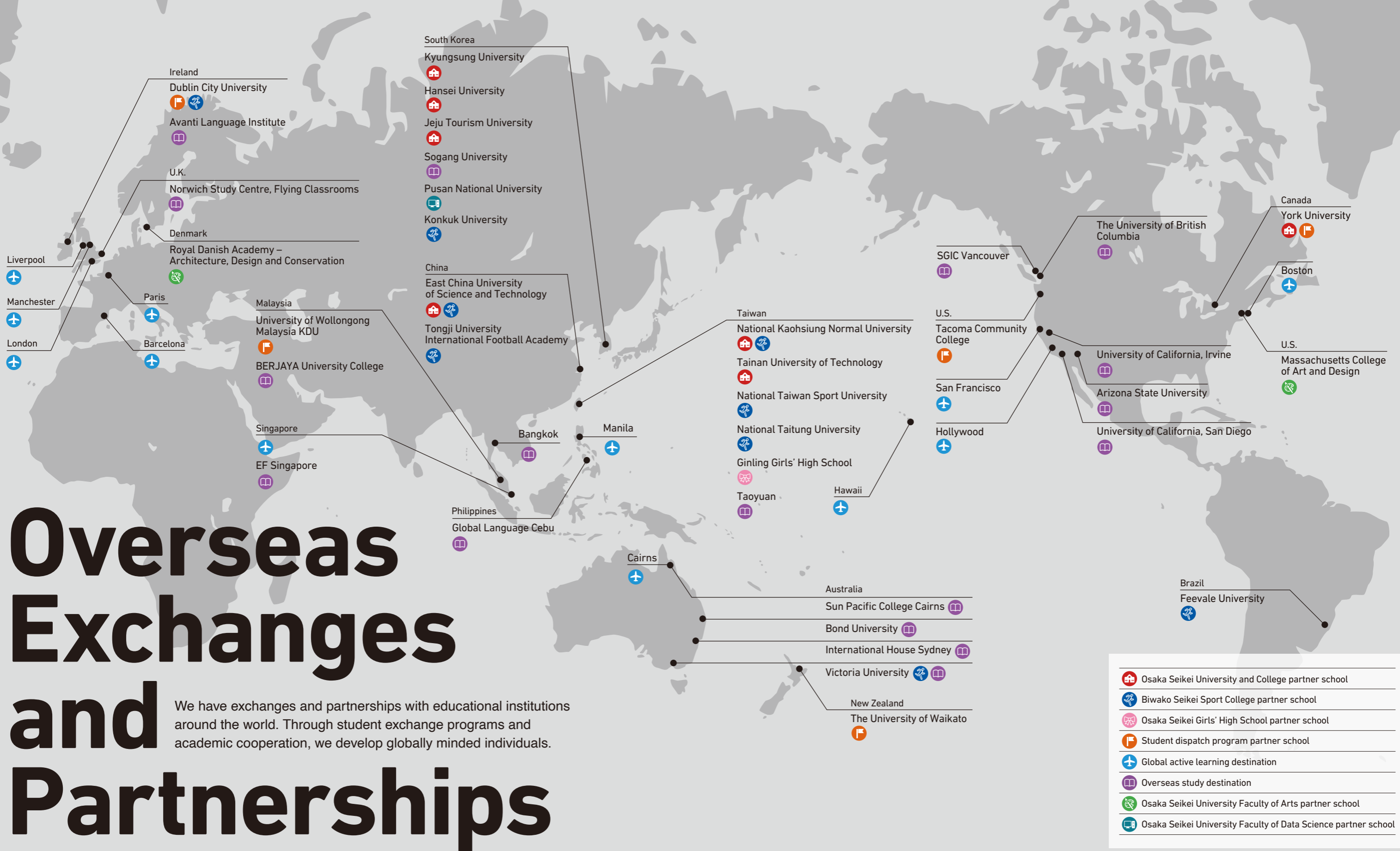
